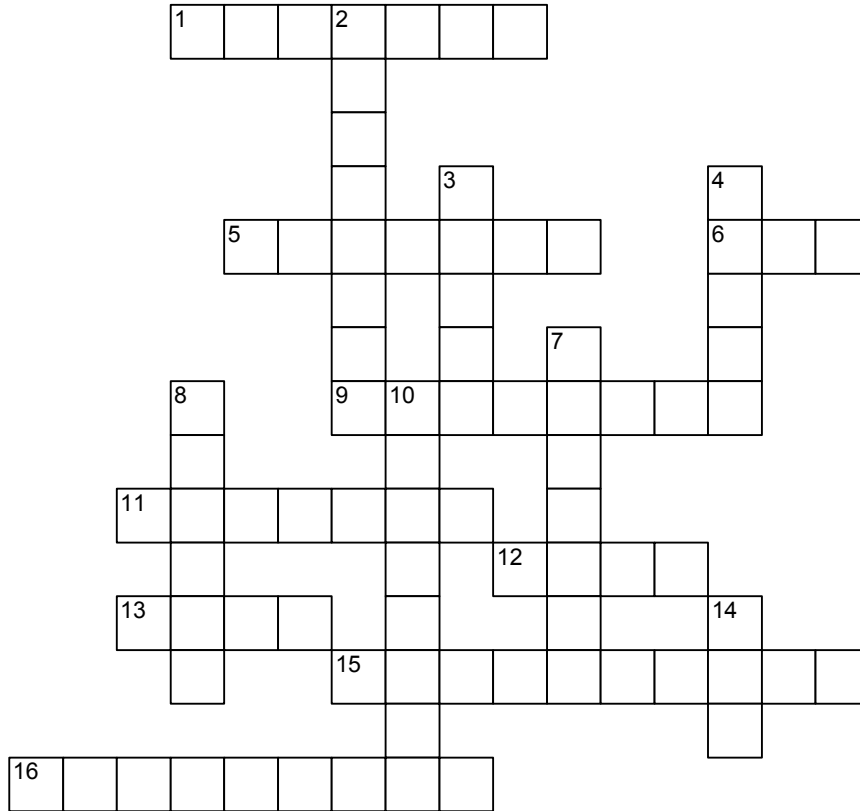

- 1 A mixture of water-saturated rock debris that flows downslope under the force of gravity (also called lahar or debris flow).
- 5 Widely spaced, fast-moving ocean wave(s) most commonly initiated by sudden displacements of the sea floor during earthquakes or submarine landslides or volcanic eruptions.
- 6 Fine fragments (less than 2 millimeters across) of lava or rock formed in an explosive volcanic eruption.
- 9 A submarine volcano. (Under the ocean)
- 11 A general term for debris that falls to the earth from an eruption cloud.
- 12 Liquid rock that flows out of the volcano
- 13 An opening in the Earth's surface through which magma erupts or volcanic gases are emitted.
- 15 The regions of mountain-building earthquakes and volcanoes which surround the Pacific Ocean. (3 words)
- 16 The name of the current active volcano in Alaska

- 2 Elongated fractures or cracks on the slopes of a volcano.
- 3 Molten rock beneath the Earth's surface
- 4 A crack or fracture in the earth's surface. Movement along the fault can cause earthquakes.
- 7 A vent in the surface of the Earth through which magma and associated gases and ash erupt; also, the form or structure (usually conical) that is produced by the ejected material.
- 8 A steep-sided, usually circular depression formed by either explosion or collapse at a volcanic vent.
- 10 When a volcano explodes sending smoke and debris thousands of feet into the air.
- 14 The number of live volcanos within 100 miles of Anchorage, Alaska
